

Embedding the player into an HTML web page

1. Unzip the contents of the package.
2. Upload the followings to your FTP folder:
 - **covers** folder (required if not empty)
 - **tracks** folder (required)
 - **Player.swf** (required)
 - **HTML** file (optional)
3. If the HTML file in which you need to embed the player is located in any other folder than the folder containing the tracks and covers and the SWF file, then you need to use the "**base**" parameter to specify the location of the tracks and covers:

```
<param name = "base" value = "/path/to/tracks/" />
```

So the final embed code should look something like this:

</object>
```

You can always use the embed code generated by our website, so you don't have to bother with hosting & HTML codes.

Example

Let's say you have your site at <http://www.yoursite.com> and you would like to show the player/playlist on the [playlist.html](http://www.yoursite.com/music/playlist.html) page, of your music category (<http://www.yoursite.com/music/playlist.html>). But you want to keep the root folder clean and do not want to have all your files and assets (images, sounds, xml files) kept on the root folder together with all of the HTML files.

For this purpose you have an *assets* folder containing all of your site's images, audio/video and xml files. And to separate the music from your other assets, you create here another folder called *player*, where you'll keep all the necessary files from the package you have downloaded from PodSnack.com (the player, the cover images and the tracks). So the player SWF file actually resides here: <http://www.yoursite.com/assets/player/>. You should place in this folder the player (Player.swf) and the *covers* and *tracks* folders from the PodSnack package you have downloaded.

In this case, the embed code used to embed the Player.swf file in the [playlist.html](http://www.yoursite.com/music/playlist.html) page should look like this:
