

The contents of the ZIP file

- The **SWF** file. Use this file to manually embed the player into a website. If you want to play it directly, you'll need the standalone Adobe Flash Player. You can find it here: <http://www.bannersnack.com/blog/download-swf-player/>.
- The **HTML** file. Double-click this file to play your tracks into the browser. You can also view the HTML's source, copy the code, and adapt it to manually embed the player into a website.
- The **EXE** file. Use this program to open the player directly on any PC, without the need of using the Adobe Flash Player.
- The **APP** file/folder. Use this program to open the player directly on any Mac, without the need of using the Adobe Flash Player.
- The **MXP** file. This file will install an Adobe Flash CS3/ActionScript 3.0 component that you will be able to use in your own Flash applications. This component does nothing more than to load the actual PodSnack player. You will need Adobe Extension Manager version 1.8+ to install the component and Adobe Flash Professional CS3+ to use it.
- The **FLA** file. This is an Adobe Flash CS3 file that already contains the loader component on the stage. This component will load the actual PodSnack player. You will need Adobe Flash CS3+ to use it.
- The **covers** folder. This folder contains a list of images used as covers for the tracks in the playlist. If the selected PodSnack player you selected does not allow displaying cover images for your tracks, then the downloaded package will contain an empty covers folder.
- The **tracks** folder. This folder contains all the tracks in your playlist.
